

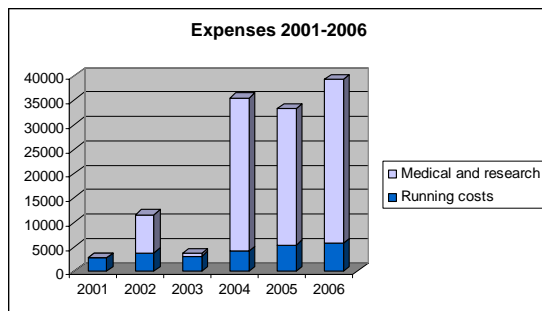
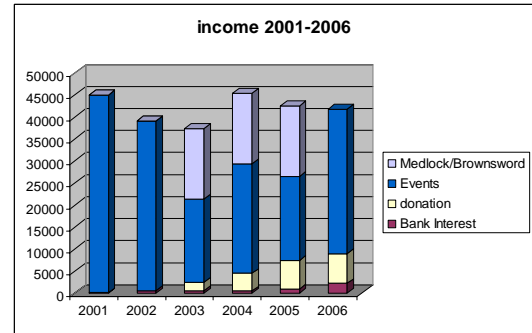


# Sophie Cameron Trust financial analysis

The Sophie Cameron Trust believes it should be transparent to its supporters, and so is providing some notes explaining our progress since our start in 2001. In addition to the public accounts filings (to be found on this website), the following may help to provide an understanding of the ebb and flow of money in and out of the Trust.

## Income.

In the early years of development, the Trust relied greatly on events for income. In 2003 we were fortunate enough to win the support of 2 major Bath-based benefactors, the Medlock and Brownsword Trusts. Events that have been great contributors over the years have been the Bath half marathon, and the Glitter Ball.



**Expenses:** The vast majority of expenditure has been into research into the causes and treatment of EL. Recording the physiotherapy treatment of Sophie herself, has given insight into effective treatments, and resulted in 2 papers being published. This, together with financial support for further international academic research into the causes of EL, has been the Trusts major area of investment.

## The future – the aims of the Trust.

The focus of the Trust will remain on research in the short term, and will eventually lead into materials that can help educate medical professionals, leading to better treatment.
